Year in Review

- Good growing season, warm dry flowering
- Timely rain events to supplement irrigation
- High number of bunches
- High quality clean parcels fruit at harvest
- Wet end to the season during harvest

Tonnages harvest 2014

- 30 T chardonnay
- 40 T pinot noir
- 53 T pinot gris
- 90 T riesling
- 711 T sauvignon blanc
- 924 T total harvest compared to 806T in 2013
